OBJECTIVES STUDENTS WILL

- achieve theme objectives;
- create a design with the name “Jesus,” practicing tracing and coloring accurately.

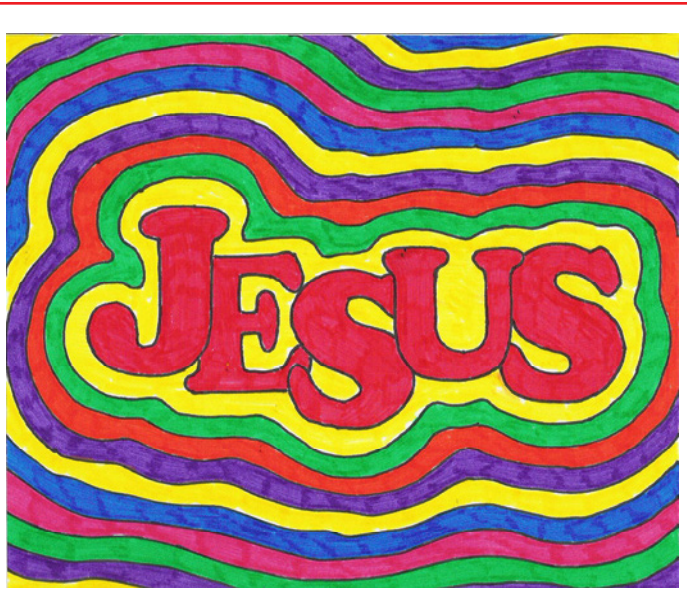

TEACHER PREP

- Trim white drawing paper to 8.5"x11" to fit through a copier.
- Copy Jesus name pattern.

MOTIVATION & FOCUS

- Present and discuss the art history image(s) recommended in the Weekly Theme.
- Present Weekly Theme information.
- Draw a rectangle on the board to represent a sheet of paper.
- Draw the name of Jesus in the center. Tell them they will be tracing the name.
- Show how to draw concentric contour lines around the name of Jesus. Show how to make their lines about a finger's width apart.
- Show how to continue the line on the other side of the name even if the line reaches the edge of the paper.
- Tell students they will be creating a design using the name “Jesus.”



MATERIALS

- Jesus name patterns on white drawing paper
- colored markers
- OPTIONAL glitter and glue
- images listed in this week's theme

ACTIVITY

- Distribute pattern copies and markers.
- Select the black marker and outline the name “Jesus.”
- Draw concentric contour lines around the Name of Jesus with black. Remind them to continue all the way around the name. If they reach the edge of the paper, begin again on the other side of the name the same distance apart. Put the black marker away.
- Fill in the letters with any color but black.
- Fill in the first space around all the letters with a lighter color. Yellow works great with all colors as a background for the letters.
- With many colors of markers (except black), students color the spaces created by the contour lines. Use only one color per concentric contour space.
- Work from the center out.
- OPTIONAL: draw a glue line on the first concentric contour line closest to the Name of Jesus. Sprinkle glitter on the glue. Set aside to dry completely before tapping off extra glitter.

Remember to use one of the evaluation tools.
