OBJECTIVES STUDENTS WILL

- achieve theme objectives;
- write the name "Jesus" following specific directions;
- create a butterfly design to resemble stained glass with the name "Jesus."

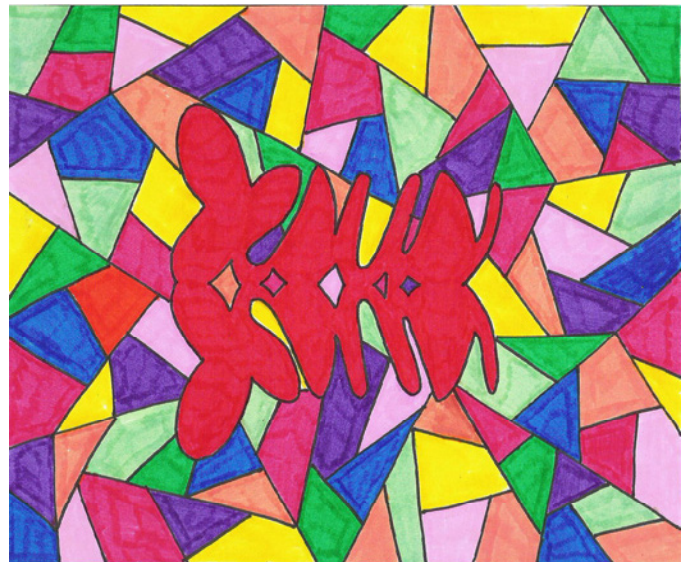

MOTIVATION & FOCUS

- Present and discuss the art history image(s) recommended in the Weekly Theme.
- Present Weekly Theme information.
- Discuss the scientific stages of the butterfly and the symbolism of rebirth.
- Tell students they will be creating a design with pattern using the name "Jesus."
- For demonstration, fold a piece of cover stock "hamburger" style (5.5"x8.5").
- With the fold at the bottom, write the name "Jesus" in large cursive letters, taking up at least half or more of the space with all letters touching the fold.
- Use marker to make the letters thicker.
- Use another color to draw a dotted line 1/8" outside the shape as in the diagram.
- Keeping the paper folded, cut out the name on dotted line.
- Open the paper to reveal a "butterfly" shape created by the name.
- Tell students they will be creating a butterfly design to resemble stained glass using the Name of Jesus.

MATERIALS

- colored markers
- pencils
- 8.5"x11" cover stock
- 9"x12" white drawing paper
- images listed in this week's theme
- erasers
- rulers
- scissors

ACTIVITY

- Distribute cover stock, pencils, erasers, and scissors.
- Fold the cover stock as in the demonstration ("hamburger" style. (8.5"x5.5"). Write the name of "Jesus" in large cursive letters with the bottom of the name touching the fold. The J will be sitting higher because the lower loop of the capital "J" must push the rest of the letter up.
- Make the letters thicker with marker.
- Draw a dotted line approx. 1/8" away from the outside of the name (see diagram at left).
- Cut out on the dotted line. Unfold to view.
- Distribute 9"x12" white drawing paper.
- Center the open cut-out on the drawing paper.
- Trace around it with pencil.
- Outline the name with black marker.
- Color the name a solid color.
- Divide the background space with straight lines into many spaces. Make spaces no larger than 3" and no smaller than 2" in length.
- Draw over the lines with black. Do not use black again.
- Color the spaces to look like stained glass. Do not repeat the same colors next to each other.
- Display horizontally so that it the images is readable and looks like a mirror image.
