OBJECTIVES STUDENTS WILL

- achieve theme objectives;
- create a design to resemble stained glass, illustrating one or more symbols and titles of Jesus with the written symbol or title.

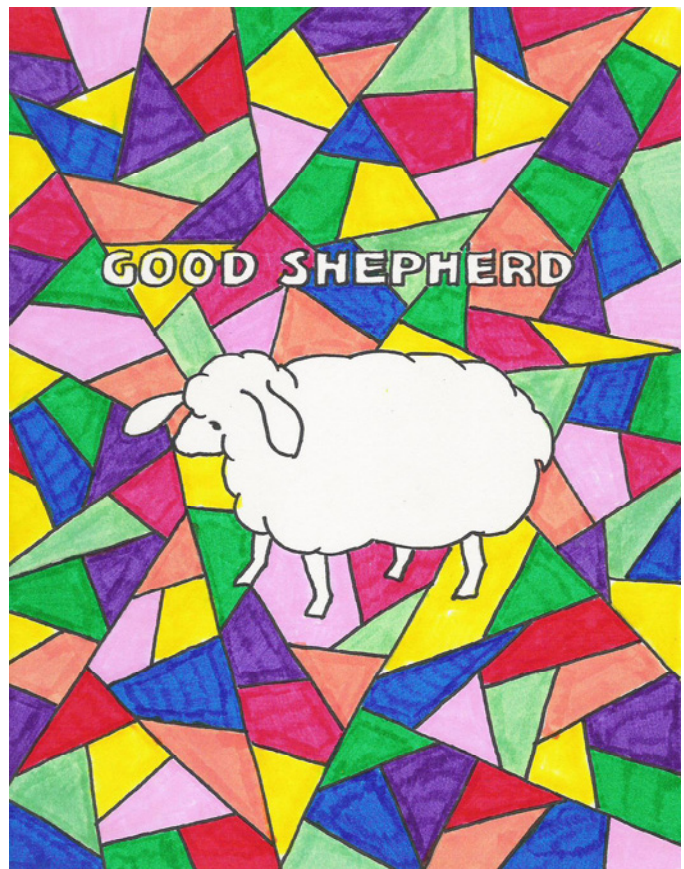

MOTIVATION & FOCUS

- Copy Symbols & Titles Poster; cut apart.
- Fold each and place in a box. Eliminate the most difficult ones to illustrate.

MOTIVATION & FOCUS

- Present and discuss the art history image(s) recommended in the Weekly Theme.
- Present Weekly Theme information.
- Display transparency of December 9. Ask students to suggest ways to illustrate the symbols and titles of Jesus.
- Choose a more difficult title to demonstrate on the board; then eliminate that one from their choices.
- Present how to arrange words and illustrations on paper for a good design (balance, arrangement, filling the space, color choices).
- Tell students they will draw a symbol/name/title from a box that they will illustrate in a design to resemble stained glass.



MATERIALS

- colored markers
- 9x12" white drawing paper
- black Sharpie® fine point marker
- transparency or poster of Symbols & Titles
- box or sack to draw out symbols or titles
- images listed in this week's theme
- pencils
- erasers
- rulers

ACTIVITY

- Students draw out a title from the box.
- Distribute 9x12" white drawing paper. Students copy design with light pencil pressure.
- If letters are to be colored black, make them at least 1/4-3/8" thick. If they are to be block letters, outline them with black.
- The illustration should be at least 4" wide.
- Outline the symbol image with black.
- Draw straight lines with pencil and rulers to divide the background into shapes like stained glass pieces.
- Draw over the lines with black. Do not use black again.
- Color with colored markers.

Remember to use one of the evaluation tools.
